Role of FACT Group Adult Advisors

To create a setting where youth can get the most out of the program, focus on addressing each level, starting with level 1, laying the foundation for each level after it.

	 Ensuring meeting space is safe, sanitary and free of physical or health
Level 1 Physically & Emotionally Safe Environment	 Ensuring meeting space is safe, safiliarly and free of physical of fleatinhazards Developing written safety rules and emergency procedures (or familiarity with those developed by the venue) Promptly defusing negative behaviors and offering mediation for behaviors that are disrespectful, hostile/aggressive or excluding others Planning any snacks offered to include drinking water and healthy options
Level 2 Supportive Environment	 Developing a consistent routine where youth can anticipate what will occur at each meeting/activity. Youth clearly understand what is expected of them and know that the adults guiding them are reliable. Preparing a meeting agenda, having all materials ready and explaining agenda activities to youth clearly Warmly greeting youth individually as they arrive and modeling welcoming behavior Asking youth open-ended questions about their work and listening to their feedback/reflections about activities Guiding youth to persevere through any setbacks and keep building skills Offering detailed encouragement regarding specific positive behaviors, rather than simply "Good job" Calmly reframing conflicts by acknowledging any hurt feelings and explaining connections between actions and consequences
Level 3 Interaction	 Sharing control of most activities with youth and providing reasons for expectations and instructions Fostering a sense of belonging with opportunities for teambuilding, icebreakers, and welcoming new youth Reviewing and implementing required FACT activities Recruitment, meetings, FACTivisms, legislative outreach, media Assigning specific, meaningful responsibilities to youth and providing support Pointing out group or individual accomplishments to the whole group
Level 4 Engagement	 Guiding youth as they create meeting agendas on their own Providing youth with choices for how to meet the group's goals and facilitating their brainstorming and planning efforts Leading youth in reflection discussions at the end of meetings or activities Collecting and employing youth feedback to improve the program and ensure authentic youth engagement Ensuring youth report all FACTivisms on FACTmovement.org
