

Tobacco-Free School Policy Scavenger Hunt

Comprehensive, all-inclusive tobacco-free policies are the gold standard for schools. But, how can you tell if your school's tobacco policy is comprehensive? Find your school's tobacco policy from your school's handbook (if it's not there, ask a school administrator for a copy). As you read through the policy, hunt for the things in the checklist below.

If you can check off everything on this list, then it's time to plan a FACTivism to thank your school for having a comprehensive tobacco-free policy! If there are still a few things that need to be checked off, then it's time to "School Your Community" and meet with your school administrators to chat about what's missing. Ask your Adult Advisor for the Sample Tobacco-Free School Policy so you can provide an example.
