What is tobaccotalk?

A moderated listserv that functions as the primary communication tool for coalitions and state partners working in tobacco prevention and control in Wisconsin.

What should I use tobaccotalk for?

- Ask a question of your colleagues
 - Share new and ongoing programs and campaigns
 - Answer timely and frequently asked questions
 - Share good and not-so-good examples of earned media coverage—and tips on how to respond to each
 - Welcome new staff, lead agencies and statewide partners
 - Announce teleconferences and meetings and share notes

- Keep messages short and to the point.

How do I reply to a tobaccotalk message?

Click "Reply" to respond only to the sender

Click "Reply All" to share your message with the whole group
